## **TRANSPORTATION**

## **2016**

In an effort to answer the many questions that arise each year concerning transportation to non-public schools, we have prepared the following summary of the most important facts.

The Education Law of New York State requires all <u>non-city</u> public school districts to provide transportation to students in grades K-12. Some of the important specifics of that law are:

- 1. Students in grades K-8 must live more than two (2) miles and less than fifteen (15) miles from the school they will attend.
- 2. Students in grades 9-12 must live more than three (3) miles and less than fifteen (15) miles from the school they will attend.
- 3. **MOST IMPORTANT**: The deadline for parents to submit requests for transportation to the Public School district is **APRIL 1, 2016.** Districts may deny (and, in fact, have denied) requests for transportation that arrive in the Public School offices after April 1. This request must be in writing. Many districts have their own special form for this purpose. We strongly urge you to obtain the proper form from your local Public School Office of Transportation. Fill out the form and return the form immediately. Early February is **NOT** too early.
- 4. City School Districts Long Beach and New York City are **NOT** required to provide transportation beyond the city limit, unless voters have approved this practice. The City of Long Beach has provided transportation to private schools for a number of years. The City of New York does not provide transportation beyond the city limits.
- 5. Late Bus School districts are not required by law to provide late bus transportation. However, many districts do provide late bus transportation. If late bus transportation is provided, it must be made available equally to non-public and public school pupils.
- 6. Kellenberg Memorial offers transportation to and from the Mineola Train Station each day.

Kellenberg Memorial provides morning bus service from the Mineola Train Station to Kellenberg Memorial. The bus arrives at the Mineola train station by 7:20 a.m., and leaves for Kellenberg Memorial by 7:50 a.m. The cost of the morning bus for the 2016-2017 school year will be \$550.00 per child to help defray the cost of the bus.

Kellenberg Memorial provides afternoon bus service from Kellenberg Memorial to the Mineola Train Station. The bus leaves Kellenberg Memorial at 5:10 p.m. each day. The bus arrives at the Mineola Train Station by 5:30 p.m. The cost of the afternoon bus for the 2016-2017 school year will be \$550.00 per child to help defray the cost of the bus.
